

Missouri Sectional/Qualifier Rules & Policies

Level 3 must qualify to state championships at a Missouri Sectional Meet

There is no qualifying score for level 3. Athletes simply need to participate in a sectional meet to qualify to State Championships.

Level 4 must qualify to state championships at a Missouri Sectional Meet

Level 4 must receive an All Around score of 28.00 to qualify to State.

Prep Optional must qualify to state championships with a 32.00 All Around.

Athlete Entry fees: Level 3 - \$30, Level 4 – \$45.00 (\$25 late fee for all) Team Entry Fee \$35.00

MOUSAG requires the use of Missouri judges for sectional/qualifying meets, however if the meet director feels this is financially unreasonable for all the judges to be from Missouri, the meet director may appeal to the MOSAC to get approval to use judges from outside Missouri as long as 50% of the judges are Missouri judges. Missouri sectional/qualifier meets may have only 1 judge panels for level 3 & 4 sessions.

Prep Optionals do require 2 judge panels at sectional/qualifier meets. (One judge must have a level 7/8 rating or higher and the other judge must have a level 5/6 rating or higher.

Age Divisions:

Level 3 - 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 & up

Level 4 – 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 & up

Prep Optional – 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13 & up

Age groups may be combined with an adjacent age group if there is only one athlete in the age group.

Gate Fees for Sectionals/Qualifiers: Adults - \$10 weekend, Children ages 5 to 12 - \$5 weekend, Under 5 free

Meet Format: Non Traditional, Capital Cup or Modified Capital Cup

Sanction Violations: 1st Offense - \$5.00 to \$500.00, 2nd Offense - \$5.00 to \$500.00

It is the meet director's responsibility to send all meet scores to the state scorekeeper within 48 hours after the event.
